Functional Limitations: Slightly impaired gait, Limited skills in money management, socialization, reading and math. She has ability to determine when water is to hot or cold. Mary has been loosing her teeth and has been having difficulty chewing her foods. Staff has been training Mary to cut her food in smaller pieces during the time she is having dental work completed and having dentures made.

Swallowing/Choking Precautions: Mary has no known incidents of choking, or reason to believe to have swallowing/eating/or drinking concerns.

Accommodations (including, but not limited to, Assistive Technology): Staff provides supervision and assistance with medication training, for Mary on a weekly basis as she has in the past threatened to take all of her pills. Her behavior is being monitored by a therapist and a psychiatrist. Staff also provides assistance for her shopping, She needs linkage to appointments and entitlements. Staff also assists with financial management as she does not have the ability to manage her finances.
