

Dignity In Pay (DIP) FEEDBACK SESSIONS

The IDD System Redesign Coalition: Disability Partners Project is grounded in feedback from various constituents involved in the system for supports and services for people with I/DD. Additionally, the Project is hinged on bringing together initiatives in Illinois to ensure efforts compliment and support each other.

This effort is launching at a time when the newly passed <u>Dignity in Pay (DIP)</u>
law's Multi-Year Plan (MYP) implementation has started. The goal of this legislation is to expand opportunities for competitive integrated employment for people with disabilities. The Institute on Public Policy for People with

Disabilities, a Disabilities Partner Project Leader, is charged with liaising with the Illinois Council for Developmental Disabilities (ICDD) to ensure alignment between the Systems Redesign Coalition and DIP. Feedback sessions will be held to inform both efforts, including feedback from workers at 3 14c organizations, providers, and families/guardians.
